



FAIR SHARE PROGRAM

The Fair Share Program is as follows: each family that chooses to do Fair Share rather than pay the additional fee are required to do (20) twenty hours of volunteer work. As you know the three mandatory hours for the Holly Fair and Auction are no longer required. We do suggest that you continue to support both of these functions.

If you choose not to participate in the Fair Share Program you will be billed a \$300.00 fee with the first tuition payment, you will also be billed \$20.00 for any unfulfilled Fair Share hour.

FAIR SHARE COMMITMENT

20 HOURS AT VARIOUS ACTIVITIES AT \$15.00 AN HOUR=\$300.00

The Fair Share commitment may be fulfilled through the following activities:

St. Joseph Mothers' Club

There are many opportunities to earn hourly credit from the Mothers' Club activities. You will receive information about the Club from the Mothers' Club President (s). We encourage everyone to join the St. Joseph Mothers' Club.

LUNCH DUTY

Your child's teacher arranges the lunch duty coverage. One hour credit is given for a lunch period. If you stay for all 3 lunch periods you will receive a maximum of 2 fair share hours. If there isn't any available lunch time in your child's class, you may come to school any day and Sister Winifred will assign you to another class. The Lunch Duty Schedule is: Grades K, 3, 4 -11:20-12:00, Grades 1,2, 5 -11:45-12:20, Grades 6, 7, 8 - 12:15-12:45. There is a LUNCH DUTY BOOK located in the cafeteria. **Please be sure to sign in (please print)**. Occasionally you may supervise a lunch period in the classroom please remember to sign in at the office.

PIZZA DAY

Pizza Day is held every Friday. Please check your monthly calendar for any changes. Mothers' Club hosts half the pizza days and the Eight Grade Graduation Committee hosts the other half. **If you are doing pizza day you must arrive at 11:00 a.m. to set up NO LATER!!!** You will receive 2 fair share hours for Pizza Day. When you arrive please see either Sister Winifred or Mr. Mauro for instructions.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (CCD)

Fair Share credit is given to any parent teaching Religious Education classes. Please contact the Religious Education office for more information at 781-395-1784. If you are planning on teaching a class please let Sister Winifred know so that she may credit you for fair share hours.

BAKING

Baked goods must be homemade **NOT STORE BOUGHT**. Please put your name and telephone number on the items. One hour credit is given for 2 dozen brownies, 2 dozen cookies, 2 dozen cupcakes, 1 large cake, and 2 small loaves of bread.

GRADUATES' BANQUET AND YEAR BOOK COMMITTEE

You will receive fair share hours for the Graduates Banquet set up. You will not receive hours for attending the meetings.

CHAPERONS

You will receive fair share hours for chaperoning a Student Council dance, a Mothers' Club dance or a school field trip. (NOT FOR CYO DANCES). Please inform Sister Winifred when chaperoning these events so that your hours may be recorded.

OTHER AREAS

Other areas include the School Board, The School Finance Committee or any other school related activity. You will receive fair share hours for attending these meetings.

PLEASE NOTE: It is imperative that all of your fair share hours are recorded and turned in immediately to Sister Winifred. Please keep a list of these hours for your records.
